Planned actions for Proposed Industrial Action on Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May

As you will be aware, the National Education Union plans to undertake industrial action on Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May 2023. After meeting with our Governing Body yesterday, it was agreed that the arrangements for the industrial action days, will

largely be the same as the previous industrial action Days last term, with the same procedural and risk assessment arrangements in place for both children and staff. What it will regrettably mean is that, once again, school will be partially open to some children and closed to others. We will also be open for some additional children, who the school will be in touch with directly.

Our breakfast club and after school club provision will also be available for those children whose classes will run as normal. I would like to emphasise that this industrial action is not against our school or any issues at our school, but is a national dispute between the government and the NEU. Undertaking industrial action which causes disruption for children and families is an extremely challenging decision for many of our staff and the decision to do so is not taken lightly. As always, we will be flexible and if the proposed strikes are called off, then school will be fully open to all. I live in hope.

To celebrate King Charles' Coronation, we are going to host a colour run for all of the Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 children in school. This will take place on Friday 5th May. We are planning to have a number of colour stations around the route where children will run past and receive red, white and blue paint that has been thrown into the air in front of the passing children. The powdered paint has the potential to stain clothes so please can we ask that children bring a change of very old clothes with them that you don't mind potentially getting stained, including old footwear/wellies! It is very important that all participants wear glasses whilst they are participating in the colour run due to colour dust in the air. Please, if possible, can you also send in a pair of sunglasses to protect your child's eyes. School will have some pairs of sunglasses for children who haven't got a pair. We want to make this day a very memorable occasion, celebrating a very rare and significant event, which the children will recall years from now as a fond school day's memory. To support the cost of the paint, we are asking for a suggested voluntary donation of £2 per child please. Payments can be made in cash on the day or through Schools Buddy. We're very excited to share this memorable day with the children and know they'll all have a wonderful day. Thank you, as ever, for your continued support.
