#### **Key Vocabulary**

**Leaf** -A leaf is part of a plant which grow from the stem.

**Root** - A root is part of the plant that attaches to the ground.

**Stem** - The main body of a plant is called a stem. **Branch** - A branch is part of a tree that grows out from the trunk.

**Trunk** - The main stem of a tree is called a trunk. Branches grow from the trunk.

**Seed** - seeds are small, hard part of a plant from which new plants grow.

**Flower** - The part of the plant where petals grow is called the flower.

**Soil** - Soil covers most land and plants can grow from it.

**Petal** - Petals are part of the flower. Petals are often brightly coloured.

 $\mbox{\bf Bulb}$  - A bulb is part of some plants which a stem then grows from.

**Grow/Growing** - Plants change when they are growing. When plants grow the are increasing in size over time.

**Tall/taller/tallest** - When we measure height we measure how tall something is. As plants grow they become taller.
